WINEMAKER NOTES

What's in a name? The word Meritage is a combination of the words merit and heritage and is pronounced like heritage. It is a registered trademark of The Meritage Alliance. Their goal is to foster exceptional wines blended in the Bordeaux tradition. Meritage wines are handcrafted, red or white wines blended from the "noble" Bordeaux grape varieties.

TASTING NOTES

With the color of melted rubies this Meritage is decadent and bold. It is filled with aromas of dark berries, dried cranberries, and under tones of leather and cedar chest. Layered flavors of Bing cherries, mulberries, with soft spice and green peppercorn all take their turn on the palate. Rounded tannins expressing tea leaf and tobacco linger on the palate to finish this exceptional Meritage off.

Food Pairing:

French Comte cheese, mushroom and caramelized onion focaccia, whole roasted cauliflower with garlic and parmesan, braised lamb shanks in red wine, dark chocolate with coarse sea salt.
