Comanche was established in the 1860s as an outpost on the Old Corn Trail, at this time it was a settlement in the middle of Comanche Indian Territory.

WINE NOTES

Appearance- dark ruby

Aromas- Youthful with aromas of black cherries, black pepper corn, and hints of five spice.

Flavors- red plum, boysenberry, and pipe tobacco with moderate tannins, bright acids and a rustic finish.

This wine is velvety and ripe for cellaring.
