### WINEMAKING + VINTAGE NOTES

*Nero d'Avola is "the most important red wine grape in Sicily" and is one of Italy's most important indigenous varieties. It is named after Avola in the far south of Sicily, and its wines are compared to New World Shirazes.*

### WINE NOTES

*Appearance-* Medium Ruby with a magenta rim

*Aromas-* fruit punch, red plums, and raisins.

*Nuances-* cigar box, black tea, and roses with a hint of earthen qualities similar to tarragon and red beets

*Flavors-* tart cherries, tobacco, and cinnamon spice.

Smooth acids and soft tannins make this an easy drinker and a fantastic pairing wine.

### PAIRINGS

Pair with veal scallopini, barbecued pork ribs, and jalapeño poppers.
