Cabernet Sauvignon 2021



WINEMAKER NOTES

Cabernet Sauvignon (kab-er-nay sah-vin-youn) is one of the world's most popular grapes. It is grown in almost every grape growing region and is often seen as a single varietal but is also used in many blends, including those from Bordeaux. Its versatility allows it to express many different flavor profiles depending on where it was grown. Texas Cabernet Sauvignon tends to be more fruit forward, expressing less minerality and terroir than those from other growing regions.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon has a deep brick color. Aromas of ripe cherry and wild blackberry, with a hint of wet slate. Blackberry carries over to the palate along with jammy huckleberry on the finish. The finish lingers with hints of espresso and dark cocoa with soft tannins.
