
Gewürztraminer 2022



WINEMAKER NOTES

Pronounced "Guh-voorts-trah-mee-ner," this grape originated in Germany. It is similar to Riesling and Moscato in that it tends to have a very floral, even sweet, aroma. It is often made into sweet or dessert style wine but can be made into very complex dry wines too.

The 2022 Gewürztraminer is made with a more fruit forward approach, not quite dry but not sweet either. It is the perfect weekday wine.

TASTING NOTES

This Gewürztraminer has a light honeyed hue with lingering legs. Aromas of clover honey and wildflowers peeking through elder flower. This mouth coating wine is full of flavors of cantaloupe and pear. Soft, with just the right amount of crispness and a hint of sweetness, it has a finish of key lime.
