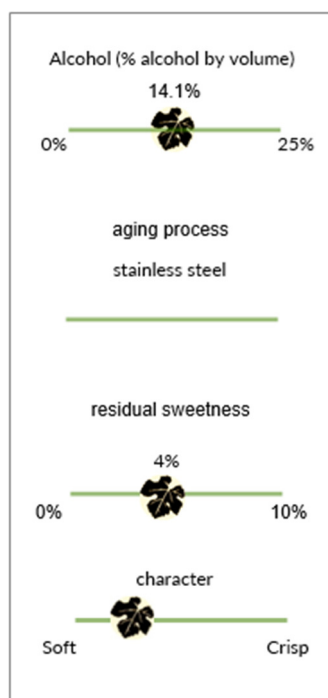
WINEMAKER NOTES

There are over 200 grape varietals belonging to the Muscat family. Muscat grapes are not just grown for wine production but also for raisins and table grapes. Although the varietal is best known for making very sweet wines, it can also be used to make crisp dry wines as well. Its versatility and hardiness keeps it a staple among wine producing regions across the world.

This Sweet Moscato is named after Lost Oak's Winery Dog, Max. Winemaking is hard work, but Max makes it a little more playful.

TASTING NOTES

Bright and inviting color of straw starts this sweet Moscato off. It has aromas of honeydew melon and Granny Smith apple with just a hint of spice. Tropical fruit flavors come alive with notes of guava, kiwi, and citrus. The finish is refreshing and lingers with a hint of key lime.
