
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


WINEMAKER NOTES

Petit Verdot (peh-tee vur-doe) originates in southwestern France. It is mostly used as a blending grape in Bordeaux style reds. It is known for its intense color.

TASTING NOTES

This Petit Verdot starts off with a rich inky purple color. Vibrant aromas of blackberry, mulberry, and black cherry with notes of vanilla overwhelms the senses. Flavors of ripe blueberry, red plum, and a hint of boysenberry are on full display. The wine lingers on the palate with notes of cranberry, and soft tannins reminiscent of white tea leaves.
