WINEMAKER NOTES

Roussanne (rue-san) is originally from the Rhone region in France. Unlike other white grape varieties, Roussanne berries tend to have a brownish hue when ripe. Roux is the French word for reddish-brown and is thought to be the origin of the varietal's name. Roussanne tends to be a fuller bodied white wine, making it a natural choice for barrel fermenting and aging. This process gives the wine more subtle and incorporated vanilla and spice flavors.

TASTING NOTES

This medium bodied, clear pale straw Roussanne will have delicate scents of stone fruit, warm toast & vanilla. On your palate you will find hints of beeswax, lemon zest and a freshly baked biscuit. Perfectly enjoyed on a beautiful fall stroll.
