Viognier has claimed the spotlight as the "white grape of Texas," but we've long made the case for Roussanne, a Rhône Valley neighbor, to take its place. Our Reserve Roussanne brings a juicy midpalate with notes of muddled lemon with a slight char, nectarine, white flowers, and a hint of saltiness. Hardly just a "quaffer," however, there's some nice texture to our 2021 from time spent in neutral oak barrels. This is "Texas Sunshine" in a glass–perfect with grilled seafood and a squeeze of lemon.
